Investigation Narrative

On 10-08-09 I was assigned an agency assist in Sedona. I was advised Fire personnel were responding to a call with several subject needing emergency medical. I responded to 13850 Angel Valley.

Upon arrival I noticed a large group of people around a make shift tent. Fire at the time was working on several subjects and several others on the ground waiting for help. Native Air was attempting to land at that time.

As I approached the scene I noticed a large group of subjects began to walk away from the scene towards the cabins. I spoke with the incident command Officer with fire. At that time they did not know the cause of the medical emergency, but advised me they had all been in the "sweat lodge". I requested more units to respond to my location. Sgt. Barbaro was also in the area and stated he would be responding.

I assisted fire in identifying the subjects. I was approached by an unknown female. The subject handed me 3 water bottles that had name tags attached to it. She advised me it was the water bottles and names of the first 3 subjects transported by fire. I advised fire of the names and secured the water bottles in my vehicle. I also noticed 2 water coolers near the "sweat lodge", which I took samples of and secured in my vehicle.

While assisting fire I noticed several subjects returning from the cabins and needing medical assistance. I and several other Deputies searched all the local building and cabins for anyone needing medical assistance. We located several subjects and requested fire to respond to the dinning hall.

The water samples and water bottles I secured in my vehicle I later booked into evidence. I conducted no interviews at the scene.
