

***Supplement:**

On 10-08-09 I was asked to respond to Angel Valley to assist Deputy Sutton with an unknown medical call.

When I arrived I was asked by Dep. Sutton to check the cabins and other structures for sick people. I was also told that the people that were in the sweat lodge were the ones who were getting sick.

Deputy C. Bollen and myself began to check the other buildings. I came across a female subject in cabin number five. She stated she had been in the sweat, and was not feeling very good. I made arrangements with a staff member to take the female to the medics in a golf cart.

As we made our way through the camp. We were met by another staff member. She told us that nobody from the Sweat lodge was past the dining Hall. She then asked if we checked on the tents. She took us to where the tents are located.

I contacted one subject who stated he was fine just a little hung over. I told him he should go see the medics to be safe. He did not want to see the medics and stated he would be fine.

I went to the area near the sweat lodge and told some of the medics about the guy in the tent. I took two medics to the tent, they spoke with him and did some tests.

I went back to the location near the sweat lodge. I began to maintain a crime scene log. while I was watching the crime scene I noticed a guy wearing a shirt and hat that said Camp Verde Fire. I noticed this subject taking a lot of pictures and I thought it was suspicious the way he was moving all around the area trying to get pictures. I later saw this subject speaking with Sergeant F. Barbro. I was then asked by SGT. Barbro to keep an eye on this subject identified as Keith Anderson. I was also told that he was not associated with Camp Verde Fire.

After things calmed down I was told to walk Keith to his car and get his hat and shirt. I obtained his hat and shirt and turned them over to Deputy Sutton. See Dr#09-040248 for more information.

I went back to the crime scene and made sure no one entered the area. I did not conduct any interviews.
